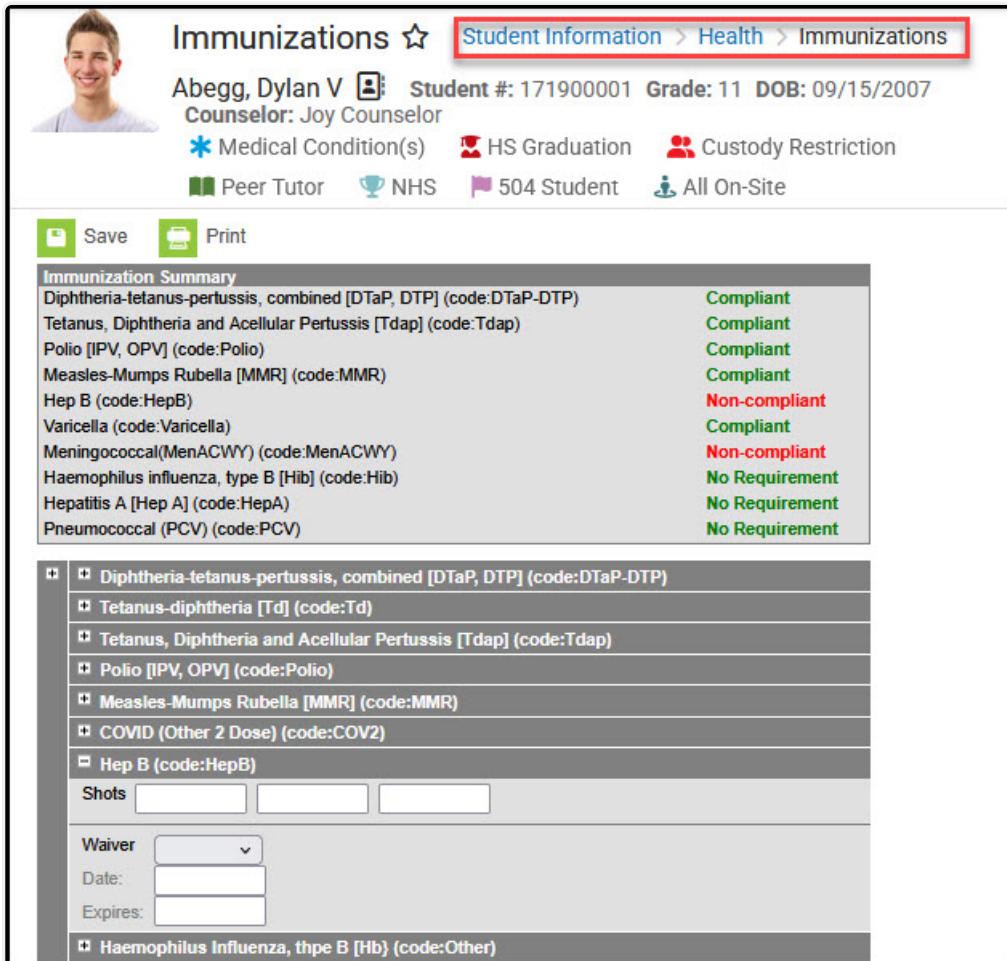


Immunizations Tool Rights
