

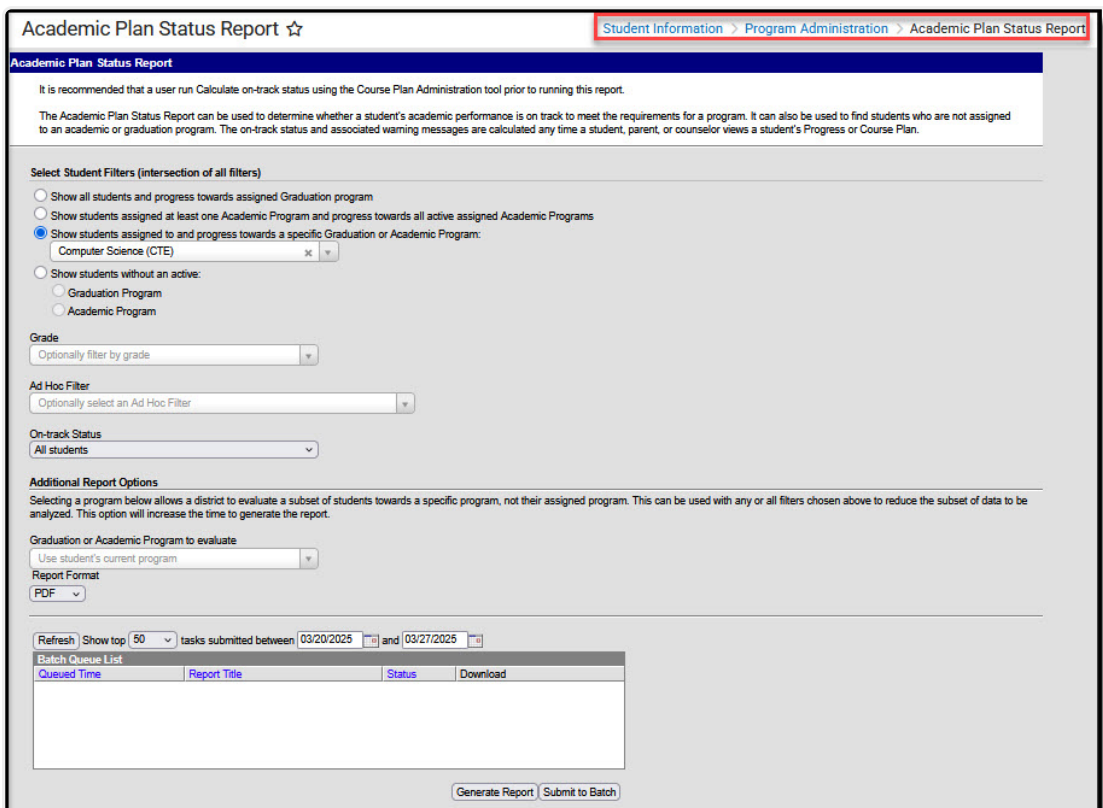
Academic Plan Status Report Tool Rights

The **Academic Plan Status Report** indicates whether a student's graduation or academic program is on track to meet minimum graduation requirements.

Only Read rights are needed for users to generate this report.
