Academic Plan Status Report

It is recommended that a user run Calculate on-track status using the Course Plan Administration tool prior to running this report.

The Academic Plan Status Report can be used to determine whether a student's academic performance is on track to meet the requirements for a program. It can also be used to find students who are not assigned to an academic or graduation program. The on-track status and associated warning messages are calculated any time a student, parent, or counselor views a student's Progress or Course Plan.
