

System Preferences Tool Rights

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The **System Preferences** module contains a variety of tools primarily used by system administrators to perform functions such as selecting how various options in Campus function (student numbers, enrollment behaviors, etc.). Grade reporting related tools might also be used by curriculum managers to perform tasks such as defining different types of report cards and the comments teachers can use when reporting grades.

Electronic Release Setup

Administrators configure Electronic Release Setup to work with eTranscript vendors that use electronic release API to establish connections for electronic release of student transcripts.
