


Cross-Site Score Groups & Rubrics Tool Rights

Cross-Site Enrollment allows schools to manage situations such as tracking and reporting on students who attend courses offered by other schools, or allowing students from other schools to take classes they offer at their own school. Grades earned by a student at a Serving School are visible at the Home School in the [Grades](#) tool, [Report Cards](#), and [Transcripts](#). For grades to flow from Serving to Home, connections must exist between grades and grading alignments. Mappings determine how grades from the Serving School are received by the Home School.
