Add/Modify a Home School Record

1. Click the **New** button. The Program Information editor displays.
2. Enter the applicable information for the student.
3. Click the **Save** icon when finished.
4. Click **Print** to display a PDF view of the student's Home School records.
5. Modify existing Home School records by clicking anywhere in the appropriate record row and making the necessary adjustments. **Save** when finished.
6. End a record by clicking anywhere in the appropriate record row and add an **End Date**. Click **Save** when finished.
