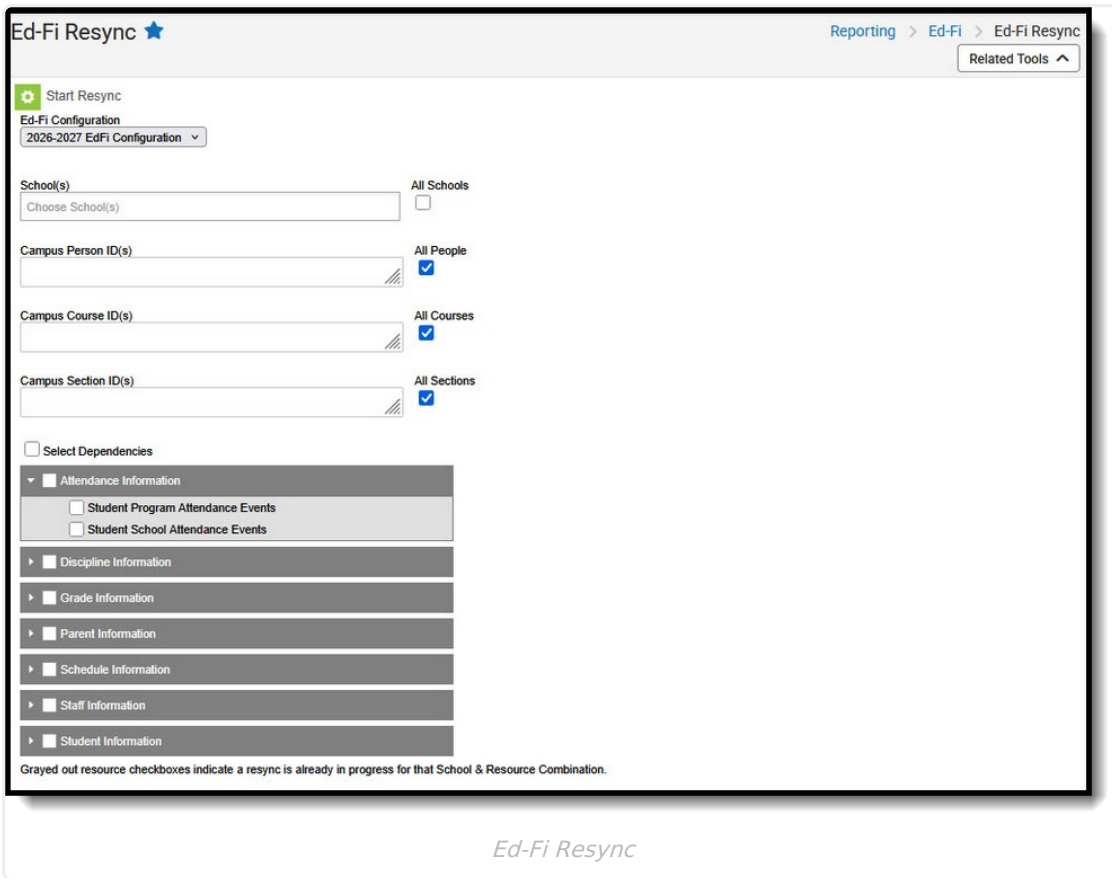


Ed-Fi Resync Tool Rights

The [Ed-Fi Resync](#) tool allows users to manually resync data from Campus to the Ed-Fi system. Although Ed-Fi data is sent from Campus to Ed-Fi in real-time (transaction-based), instances where the connection is lost, records appear not to have been sent, or other various instances may require you to manually request a resync of specific data.
