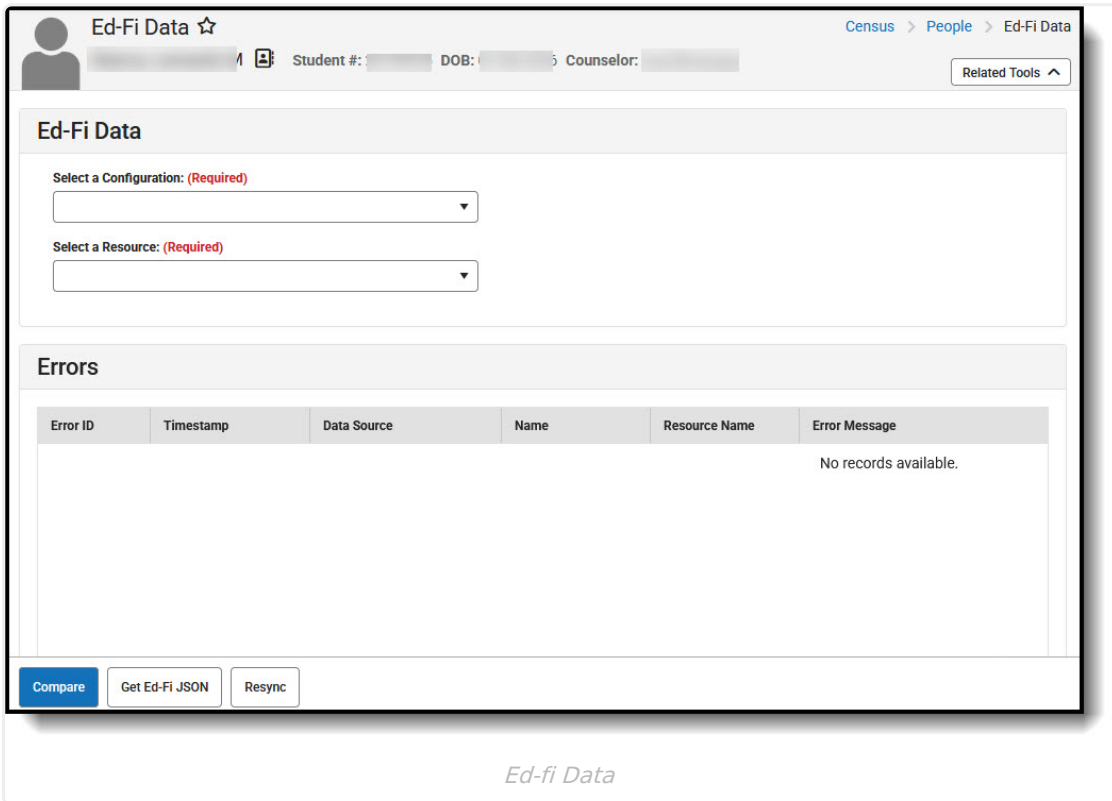


Ed-Fi Data Tool Rights

The [Ed-Fi Data](#) tool allows users to compare person-related [Ed-Fi resources](#) with the data in Infinite Campus. To compare data, a configuration and a resource need to be selected.
