

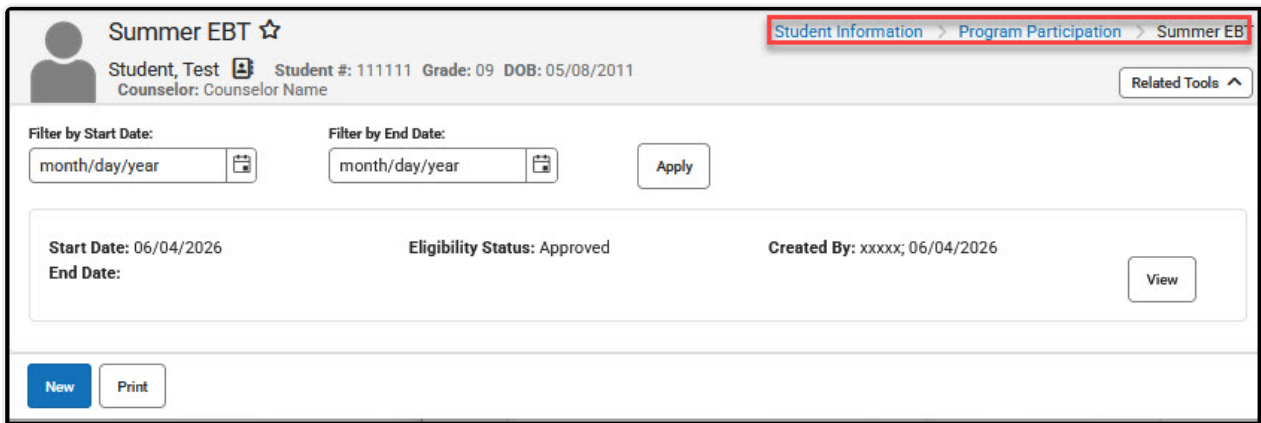

The Summer Electronic Benefits Transfer (Summer EBT) program provides grocery benefits for eligible school-age children while school is out for the summer. Districts can use the **Summer EBT** tool to record information about students associated with this program. Summer EBT is included in [Student Records Transfer](#) and [National Records Exchange](#).

This tool is read-only for state level State Edition users. Some options and selections may vary by state.

New records can be entered for students to capture information about their participation in the Summer EBT program.

1. Select **New**.
2. Enter a **Start Date** that indicates when the student began participating in the Summer EBT program. **Note that Summer EBT Start and End dates are not tied to student enrollment or school calendar records.**
3. An **Eligibility Status** must be selected in order to save this record.
4. Enter other eligibility information as appropriate. Follow local practices when selecting

options or entering information.

5. Select the **Household Address dropdown** to select the mailing address associated with the student. If appropriate, an address may be manually entered in the fields provided.

Requirements for selecting and/or entering address information vary by state. Your district or state may require this for the purpose of mailing EBT cards.

6. **Save** when done.

State Edition Customers:

- A record saved by State Edition level users is saved without a DistrictID, indicating this is a state owned record.
- A record saved by a District level user is saved with a DistrictID.

Address Information

The Address Information editor is used in the process of associating and syncing household address information from districts to the state for the Summer EBT program. Your district or state may require this for the purpose of mailing EBT cards. Follow your local guidelines when selecting or entering this information. Fields marked as required may vary by state.

Your district or state may require the entry of address information in order to send EBT cards.

Option 1: Users may select an address from the Household Address dropdown. Only active addresses marked for mailing that are attached to the student's household display in this list.

Option 2: Manually enter address information.

- This address ONLY displays in the Summer EBT Program. This is the address that will sync and display in the State Edition of the program for State Edition customers.
- This address WILL NOT be added to the list of household addresses and will not display outside the program. For example, the address will not appear in Census > Addresses for assignment to other households.

Update Summer EBT record

1. Use **Filter by Start Date** and/or **Filter By End Date** if there are many records and you wish to limit the records displayed by date.

2. Select **View** from the right side of the record you wish to view.
3. Make changes as appropriate. **Save**.

USDA-required eligibility methods

Selections available for fields in this tool correspond to USDA-required eligibility methods.

Automatic (categorical) eligibility

- **Certified** for free or reduced price meals
- Member of household receiving **SNAP**, **TANF**, **FPDR**, or (depending on state) **Medicaid**
- **Homeless, migrant**, in **foster care**, in **Head Start**

School enrollment-based eligibility

- NSLP/SBP schools
- Special Provision schools (e.g. CEP, Provision 2/3)

Application-based eligibility

- Applications may be submitted for children not automatically certified
- Families must be less than or equal to 185% of the Federal Poverty Level

Program element attributes

- Standard and Program elements are defined in the [Attribute Dictionary](#).
- States may choose to add State Defined attributes.
- Districts may choose to add District Defined attributes.

Overlapping Records Logic

An alert will display if a user attempts to enter a record that is considered to overlap another record (e.g. Start and End dates, record type, or District vs. State record ownership).

State Edition customers

- A District Owned and State owned record **can** overlap each other
- Two records with the same ownership (State OR District) **cannot** overlap each other

When programs are allowed to overlap by type

- Two records of the **same** type **cannot** overlap each other
- Two records of **different** types **can** overlap each other

Records transfer/program updater

- The PDF Summer EBT Summary Report is available in Student Records Transfer, National Records Exchange, and DIS.
- Summer EBT Program Elements and State Defined fields can be bulk updated under Summer EBT in the Federal/State Program Updater Wizard.
- The Data Change Tracker tool can be used to monitor changes to program records.

Field Name	Definition	Adhoc Field
	Reports a numbered ID for an entered Summer EBT record.	summerEBT.summerEBTID
	Reports the student's personID	summerEBT.personID
	Reports the DistrictID of the district entering the information. Note that for State Edition customers, records entered at the state level will not have a districtID.	summerEBT.districtID
	Reports a unique identifier for the Summer EBT record.	summerEBT.EBTGUID
Start Date	Indicates the date the student began participating in the Summer EBT program. Note that this is not tied to enrollment or calendar dates.	summerEBT.startDate

Field Name	Definition	Adhoc Field
End Date	Indicates the date the student stopped participating in the Summer EBT program. Note that this is not tied to enrollment or calendar dates.	summerEBT.endDate
Eligibility Status	The code assigned to the selected status of the student's eligibility for Summer EBT. For example, a selected status of 03: Approved reports as 03 .	summerEBT.eligibilityStatus
Eligibility Basis	Code assigned to status that indicates why a student is eligible for Summer EBT. For example, 01: FRAM reports as 01 .	summerEBT.eligibilityBasis
Eligibility Date	Date that the student's eligibility became effective.	
Tribal Eligibility	When selected, this checkbox indicates that the student has automatic eligibility due to participation in Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) or Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF). Reports 0 if not selected, 01 if selected.	summerEBT.tribalEligibility
Issuance Status	Indicates the status of eligibility issuance. For example, 01: Received reports as 01 .	summerEBT.issuanceStatus
Issuance Date	Indicates the date corresponding to the Issuance Status.	summerEBT.issuanceDate
Denial Reason	Indicates the reason Summer EBT eligibility was denied. For example, 02: Opt Out reports as 02 .	summerEBT.denialReason
Income Verification	Code assigned to applicant's income verification status. For example, 01: Income Verified reports as 01 .	summerEBT.incomeVerification
State Direct Certification	When selected, this checkbox indicates that the student was certified directly by the state as eligible for Summer EBT.	summerEBT.stateDirectCertification
Residency Verified	When selected, this checkbox indicates that residency requirements for the student were verified. Reports 0 if not selected, 01 if selected.	summerEBT.residencyVerified

Field Name	Definition	Adhoc Field
Appeal Outcome	Applicants may submit an appeal when benefits are denied. This field indicates the result/status of the appeal. For example, 01: Successful reports as 01 .	summerEBT.appealOutcome
Comments	This is a text field with a 255 character limit that can be used to enter additional information to the selected Summer EBT record.
